9. **Program:**

56th House District...Tim McGinnis emphasis was on roads, infrastructure planning for more roads as development continues, as well as 24-hour police station. McGinnis stated "what he hears from people over and over again is they want better response times, and they also want to feel safe in our communities."

56th House District...Dwyer Scott.... Is a Chiropractor in Carolina and Myrtle Beach area, his office offers stem cell therapies for injuries and chronic pain He stated that the same regenerative medicine is very promising for chronic pain and being a part of chronic pain solution that would help out with opioid epidemic. He wants to focus on increasing the amount of road and police that would service the Carolina Forest area. He stated the goal is to stop the steady increase of state taxes and fees but allocate the re-repurpose the funds we have already have in place.

56th House District...Adam Miller....supports term limits for members of the General Assembly, four year terms or eight years for House members, and two terms or eight years for Senate members. He also said he hopes to see a referendum in the future on incorporating Carolina Forest, which has been a rapid population growth. He wants to see this area to be better represented and have a mayor and city council.”
